Improve the current business models considering market designs with a focus on competitiveness and Life Cycle Analysis (LCA).

3

Implement the improved business models with real data, monitor them in the United Kingdom, Belgium, Germany, France, Austria, Italy, Cyprus, Spain and Portugal & replicate them across the European Union.
